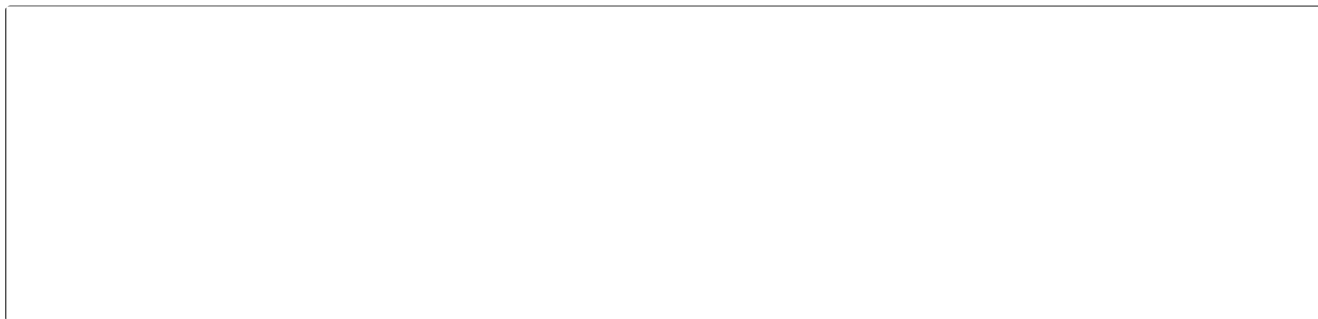

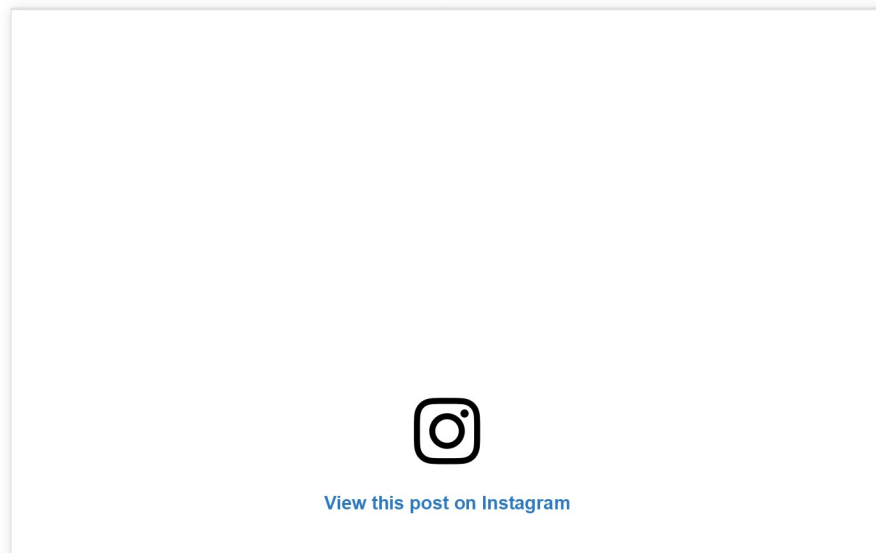

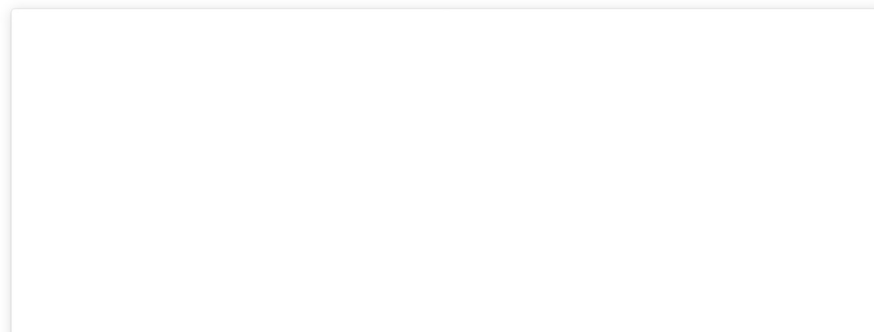
17. The Global Goddess
